

THEIR COMPANY CHARGES 30% TO THEIR CLIENTS ON THE PRINCIPLE AMOUNT COLLECTED, MUNICIPAL COURT DEBTS THE 30% IS ADDED TO THE DEBTOR AND COLLECTED DIRECTLY FROM THEM, AS WELL AS ON, RETURNED CHECK COLLECTIONS. THEY WILL SUBMIT COLLECTIONS DIRECTLY TO THE KANSAS SETOFF PROGRAM AND MANAGE ALL COLLECTIONS. THEY HAVE COLLECTION LAWYERS ON STAFF WITH THE CAPABILITY OF PROVIDING LEGAL COLLECTIONS. THERE ARE NO SIGN-ON FEES TO THE CONTRACT.


