Pt. usually goes to HF Hospital & settled dtr stated she prefers pt. stay @ MHC. Pt's dtr. signed code II status & states that her entire family is in agreement to this decision. Ms. Lewis & pt have an adopted dtc, Chandra Danette Clark, who wishes to be involved in pt's hospitalization / decision making. Pt's dtc, Kallene Ruthford had not acknowledge pt had any other children & did not want others involved in pt's care - only herself, pt's parents, & pt's sister. Ms. Lewis explained she would like to pursue co-guardianship - both dtc's sharing guardianship & has stated a petition has been filed in Wayne County where pt resides. SW attempted to reach dtc, Kallene Ruthford, at home & work - messages left

Chart reviewed. Case discussed @ RN + Dr. M Al-Hadidi this Am. Met at length w/pt. Then met @ his 2 daughters, Chandrat + Kaleen. Pt's condition exhibiting improvement. MD indicates probable extubation 9/23 or 9/24/97. Pt appears very alert today. Answered all questions (except year) appropriately. Asked pt if he has 1 daughter - he ^{shook head} said "no" - asked pt if he has 2 daughters - he said "yes". S.W. asked pt if he wants his visitors to be limited to only his daughters - he shook head "NO". Asked pt if he wants open visiting to all family/friends - shook head "yes". S.W. notified MHC Info desk + daughters of above. All are in agreement. Notified daughters of ^{their} equal legal authority re: pt's care. Explained the reasoning to them. Both state understanding. Explained code form to both. New document completed. Both daughters have signed. Explained that if pt remains A + x3 after extubation, he will be asked to sign own code form + to complete DPOA + living will. Explained need of daughters to communicate with one another + support each other + pt. during his hospitalization + recovery. Kaleen states pt lives in 2nd floor apt. Plan after %c is for pt to stay @ his sister in 1st floor apt. Notified them of Dr. M. Al-Hadidi's plan for extubation, P.T., + hopeful inpt. Rehab. S.W. also explained alternative %c options if needed. Emotional support provided to both.
