

ORDINANCE NO. 2014- 12

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN CODE TO PROVIDE FOR A FINE
CONSISTENT WITH MODERN REGULATION**

WHEREAS, the Town council of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana (the "Town Council") has determined that the fines for violating Section 6-84 have not been modified since 1891, and;

WHEREAS the fine level set in 1891 is no longer an effective deterrent to the prohibited behavior.

BE IT ADOPTED

That Section 6-84 (b) of the Town Code be amended to read as follows:

Any person found guilty of violating this section shall be fined in the sum of not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$125.00) for a first offense in any one calendar year. A second offense within the same year will result in a doubling of the fine. Each additional violation within a year will result in the fines being multiplied by the sequential number of the violation. In no event will the fine exceed the statutory maximum.

This ordinance supersedes and replaces any rule regulation or ordinance that conflicts with its provisions.

All remaining provisions in Section 6 remain in full force and effect.

This ordinance is effective as of the date of passage and publication as required by law.
