**THEME:** This is a Rogues general show. There is no theme. Due to the exhibit fee being charged the group, there will be no awards. This is a non-competitive show. This is a new market so work does not need to be recent. Bring your best pieces.

**ELIGIBILITY & RESTRICTIONS:** Open to all Rogues Artists Group members in good standing. Sculpture, artists' books, assemblage, photography, metalwork, collage all welcomed. **40 – 60 pieces are needed.** Work submitted should not have been shown at the Beloit Art Center before. Work submitted must be original. Compositions from published material, other artist's work, or from photographs not taken by the artist are not considered original works.

Artwork exhibited must be appropriate for viewing by all ages of the general public. Artwork that is overtly sexual, racist, violent, libelous, slanderous, demoralizing or discriminatory in nature is strictly prohibited. All art must have a label with artists name, title, size, medium and price attached.

**An artist's statement about the work, the technique or your inspiration for the work must be emailed as part of your entry form. There is a new space on the online entry form that has been added for this purpose. The online application form is located on the Rogues Artists Group website, [www.roguesartists.org](http://www.roguesartists.org) and is accessed by clicking on our logo.**

**2-D WORK:** must be appropriately framed and wired for hanging unless otherwise stipulated by the artist and the Rogues will be responsible for the installation and hanging of all artwork. Sawtooth or ring hangers are not allowed. The Beloit Art Center allows nails and picture hangers only.

**3-D WORK:** Beloit Art Center enthusiastically accepts 3-D work. They have 15-20 pedestals in various sizes plus shelves and tables.

**COMMISSION:** Artwork does NOT need to be for sale. NFS allowed. Beloit Art Center will receive a commission of 30% on all sales as a result of the exhibit.

**DELIVERY:** Drop off all artwork at the Beloit Art Center. There will be several vehicles making the hour and 15-minute journey. If you are going, please volunteer to deliver for a few of your fellow Rogues. We will be collecting names of those who CANNOT make the journey and need their work delivered. All shipping, handling or delivery charges are the responsibility of the artist.

**PACKAGING:** Make sure your work is properly packaged, especially if someone else is delivering for you. Drivers will not be responsible for damage to others work if it has not been properly packaged and may refuse to deliver work at their discretion.

**AGREEMENT:** Submission of work indicates acceptance of all conditions set forth here. Works are **not insured** while on the premises of the Beloit Art Center. Any damage or loss is the sole responsibility of the artist.

**OPENING RECEPTION:** The Beloit Art Center will be coordinating the reception and providing beer wine and soft drinks. Due to Covid restrictions, we will be updating everyone with any changes.
