REPORT ON MEETING WITH TRAVEL COUNCIL - BILL AND NED: Bill said they presented the Board's request to the Travel Council for funding to assist in the maintenance of the Ken's Lake recreation area. Bill said immediate funding would help but understood they are in COUNCIL the middle of their budget period. The Travel Council said they would take the request under consideration.
