SPECIAL MEETING-----July 27, 1981

Special Meeting called to order by Chairman, K.E. McDougald at 8:00 p.m. in the district office. Grand County Water Conservancy District members present: Bob Norman, Curt Young, D.L. Taylor, Sam Taylor, and Ev Schumaker.

Also present at the meeting: Executive Director Dave Bretzke, Mark Page and LaMond Gardner from the State Engineers Office.

Bretzke discussed the use of water by the high-water users on the Mesa thus far this summer.

DISCUSSION OF
HIGH-WATER USE

Mark Page presented a brief summary of the water rights of record in the office of the State Engineer on Mill Creek dated July 16, 1981.

Legally the high-water users on the Mesa are required to shut off use of water when Mill Creek flow reaches 20.35 cfs. The Board reviewed a letter from Moab Irrigation Co., which indicated cut-off dates of high-water users since 1966. The average cut off date has been June 20 when the flow dropped below 20.35 cfs.


Schumaker suggested that we raise the elevation of the diversion dam with 2x4's or 2x6's as discussed at a previous meeting.

Sam Taylor stated that he was going to meet with Temple Reynolds, the new director of the Department of Natural Resources, on Friday, July 31. He would discuss with Mr. Reynolds the letter that we received from Pete Parry, Supt. of Canyonlands National Park, regarding a request for recreation planning assistance. Also the need for the State's assistance in having these resources planned properly and the need for a comprehensive plan in the Park development.
