DESCRIPTION: IMO the Super Necedah is one of the best short hunting bows ever designed—smooth, fast and accurate. I've owned and shot more than a dozen of them. Great looking and performing recurve. Zebra-wood and Seduha riser. Comfortable grip. Beveled arrow shelf. Factory installed stabilizer bushing. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Some wear to the limbs. Decals are in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a new replica Shakespeare rest and side plate, and a lightly used string with silencers.

This bow sold for \$75 in 1969, which translates to \$664 in 2025 inflation adjusted dollars.
