Howdy said there had been some issues with EchoLink and Mathison Ott KJ6DZB has resolved some networking issues, website port forwards, and other issues. The nets seem to be okay but hard to keep 440 all the time. The batteries for the mesh system are soon to be installed. Howdy is also

working on documenting and updating our equipment for insurance purposes; the deadline is March 30. With the additions of batteries and the setup for mesh, the value will be more: the price was \$1.40 per \$100, but he figures around \$22,000 value now. Jay reported that Ron Smith KE6RS requested help to take down his antenna. Jay will check it out for functionality and see if anyone would like to buy it.
