<b>Content Terminology, Quotes, Images, Legacy statement(s)</b>	-Correct terminology quotes, maps/images used for people and events -Specific Significance clear in Legacy statement(s) in rectangular boxes- (modeled)	-Some mistakes in terminology, lack of many appropriate quotes, maps/images for people and events, -Too General-lacks specificity in Legacy statement(s)	-Appropriate terminology not used, lacks quotes, images, maps. -Missing many Legacy statements	-No terminology, maps, images used -No legacy statements evident
<b>Connections and relationships among people, events</b>	-Clear logical connections evident among people, events showing use of logical critical thinking skills	-Many connections are somewhat evident among people and events	-Very few clear connections between people and events are evident	-No connections are evident
<b>Collaboration</b>	-Pairs worked together, clearly evident discussing, researching, synthesizing events and people, taking turns recording information on mind map -No divide and conquer evident	-Pairs worked mainly together, mostly researching, discussing events and people together, some divide and conquer evident	-Little real evidence of true collaboration, mainly separated tasks to complete	-No evidence of any collaboration, only divide and conquer tasks
<b>Legitimacy/ Honor (Either/or)</b>	-Pairs created original mind map not based on any previous created work with no evidence of copy/paste or plagiarism. Resources cited clearly on back of map(s)	—	—	-Pairs copy/pasted previously created works. Resources not cited
