### 2024 Garbage Rate Schedule

*Effective January 1, 2024, the new garbage rate schedule reflects a 2% increase by Empire Disposal and a 10% disposal fee increase imposed by Spokane County.*

*Per Empire Disposal, rates per month for weekly pickup:*

- \$20.80 - 32 gallon can
- \$25.95 - 2 cans
- \$27.80 - 1-65 gallon cart
- \$33.75 - 3 cans
- \$41.20 - 4 cans
- \$28.95 - 90 gallon cart

- \$81.10 - 1 yard
- \$121.70 - 1.5 yard
- \$162.10 - 2 yard

- \$324.30 - 4 yard
