

# STUART W. BAUER

## 1947 - 1996

After a lifetime of muscular dystrophy, Stuart W. Bauer, 48 of Sebewasing, died Wednesday afternoon, Jan. 31, at his home, following a brief illness.

He was born Oct. 16, 1947, in Pigeon, the son of Reinhart L. Bauer and the late Eda Louise (Alward) Bauer.

He was a 1965 graduate of Michigan Lutheran Seminary in Saginaw, and attended Concordia College, Ann Arbor, and Concordia College, Seward, NE, graduating in 1970. He was united in marriage with Mary M. Scherping on July 18, 1970, in Cic.

Mr. Bauer taught school in Athens, W., for three years and later taught at Immanuel Lutheran School, Sebewasing, for four years. He then was employed at Huron County Commission on Aging and with Nordstrom Tax Service.

He was a member of Immanuel Church, Sebewasing, where he served on the board of youth, building committee and taught Sunday School.

Surviving, besides his wife Mary are two sons, Todd D. Bauer of Troy and Matthew R. Bauer of Ann Arbor, one daughter, Crystal D. Bauer at home, his father, Reinhart L. Bauer of Pigeon, and several aunts, uncles and cousins.

One brother, David Bauer, preceded him in death.

The funeral service took place at 11 a.m. Saturday, Feb. 2, in Immanuel Church, with Rev. Martin Hagenow officiating. Burial was in the church cemetery. Dinkus-Juengel Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.
