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WATER MAINS BEYOND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE  
VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Chapin has received requests for permission to tap onto the Village water system by persons residing outside the corporate limits of the Village and to extend water mains and service beyond said corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village desire to establish rules and regulations regarding such requests and extensions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Limits of Service. Village water service is for the primary and exclusive use of residents and properties located within the corporate limits of the Village of Chapin; and said service shall only be extended to residents within the corporate limits of the Village, except as provided in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Extension of Service. The corporate authorities may contract with persons, corporations, governmental units or municipal corporations or other users to extend water service beyond the corporate limits of the Village of Chapin upon such terms and conditions as the corporate authorities may deem to be appropriate and in the best interest of the Village at that time.

SECTION 3. Determination of Extending Service. In determining whether to allow service to be extended beyond the corporate limits of the Village, the Board of Trustees may consider if said extension is economically feasible based upon any present or projected costs the Village may incur as a result of said extension and the number of existing potential users that will use water along the extension; the capacity of the water system; current and projected demand from within the corporate limits; limitations upon the water systems' capability; cap on the Village's water purchases; and such other additional matters determined to be relevant.

SECTION 4. Expense of Extension. The Village shall not pay the cost for any extensions to a resident or area outside the corporate limits of the Village. As a condition of permitting said extension, all costs and expenses, including, but not limited to, the Village's reasonable engineering fees, inspection fees and attorney fees, shall be paid by the user or users desiring said service.

SECTION 5. Installation of Extension. All extensions shall be

made by the user or users desiring service only after contracting with the Village for said service and receiving the written consent of the Village to construct said extension. Prior to installation of any extensions and tapping onto the Village water system, the user or users must:

- (a) Submit plans and specifications of the proposed extension to the Village for approval;
- (b) Submit plans and specifications to all federal or state agencies as required by law and obtain any necessary permits;
- (c) Obtain right-of-way easements for all extensions and title evidence of the same;
- (d) Obtain the approval and consent of the City of Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois to the extension; and
- (e) Comply with such other requirements set by the corporate authorities.

SECTION 6. Annexation to the Village. If the property or properties to be serviced by the proposed extension are contiguous, or form a unit that is contiguous, to the corporate limits of the Village of Chapin, then, as a condition of permitting said extension, the owner or owners of the property to be serviced shall be required to annex said property to the Village of Chapin. If the property to be serviced is not contiguous, then the corporate authorities, as a condition of permitting said extension, may require the owners of the property to be serviced to execute a Pre-Annexation Agreement upon such terms as determined by the corporate authorities.

SECTION 7. Conformance with Village Rules, Rates and Regulations. All water users outside the corporate limits shall conform to all provisions of all ordinances of the Village establishing policies, rules, rates and regulations for the Village water system or service.

SECTION 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

SECTION 9. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 10. Repeal. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Village of Chapin, Illinois conflicting with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
