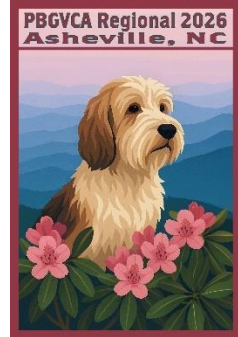
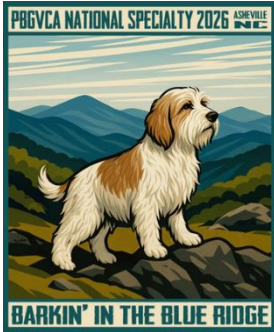

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

SAME CLASSES FOR DOGS AND BITCHES

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed

NOTE: Non-Regular Classes follow same fee schedule as Regular Classes

Veteran Classes – Veterans 7 years and under 11 years

Veterans 11 years and older

At independent specialties Neutered dogs and Spayed bitches may compete.

Hunt Classes – For dogs & bitches who have earned the Parent Club Junior Hunter title. The class will be judged according to the AKC breed standard.

At independent specialties Neutered dogs and Spayed bitches may compete.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Neutered dogs and Spayed bitches may compete.

Stud Dog Class Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Although the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has any condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

Brood Bitch Class Same as for Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class - Entry fee \$38.00 per Brace. The two dogs with identical ownership comprising a brace must be named at the time of the entry, only a single entry fee for the brace class is required. If a dog, which is to be part of a brace, is not entered in a single class entry, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only" for a fee of \$38.00. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for each dog entered in another class and entered as part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes as "Brace Class". If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH brace must be designated, Brace No. 1, Brace No. 2, etc.

Pack Class (National Specialty Only) Entry fee \$38.00 per Pack. The pack consists of an entry of at least 6 dogs that are all bred, co-bred, owned or co-owned by the exhibitor. The entry is made in the name of the kennel represented by the dogs as well as the exhibitor's name(s). The dogs are brought into the ring by up to 2 handlers, one of which must be the named exhibitor. The dogs will be judged on a point system with 120 being the maximum. Half the points (60) are allotted for how well the pack corresponds to breed type, and the other half (60) are allotted on size (30) and color (30) of the whole. The dogs are judged as a pack rather than as individuals; they are judged on type, size and color as a whole, they are not gaited. All dogs judged in the pack class must be entered in the regular classes. The judges shall choose one winner. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a pack must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Pack Class". If more than one pack is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each pack must be designated "Pack No. 1, Pack No. 2", etc.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries, cont'd

Three Generation Pedigree Class (National Specialty Only) Entry fee is **\$38.00 per unit**. Each entry will consist of 3 specified PBGVs, dogs and/or bitches from 3 different generations, e.g. sire daughter grandson, in any combination as long as they are direct descendants. The 3 generations need not be consecutive. All 3 dogs must be bred, co bred, owned or co owned by the exhibitor. All three will be listed in the catalog. The entry is judged as a unit, with no one outstanding individual outweighing the quality of the others. All are judged on how well they represent the ideal of the breed standard, quality and consistency. The quality of each generation should meet or exceed that of the previous generation. The judge shall choose one winner.

All dogs entered in the Three-Generation Pedigree Class except the grandsire and/or granddam **must be entered** in another Regular or Non-Regular class at the show. If the grandsire and/or granddam are representing another Generations Class either as a Sire or Dam, then the grandsire and/or granddam **MUST BE ENTERED** in another Regular or Non-Regular class at this show.

3 Point Major Reserve

Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held.

Judge's Award of Merit

At the conclusion of Best of Breed judging, after picking Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, and Select Dog & Select Bitch, the judge at his discretion may choose up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry for an Award of Merit. Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch may not be considered by virtue of their already higher placement. The AOM percentage will be rounded up.

Grand Championship Points

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch.

National Specialty Club Trophies

For wins at the annual PBGVCA National Specialty; members in good standing only; with three wins (not necessarily with the same dog) trophies may be retired or replaced per club rules. Trophies are presented at the Annual Award Banquet following the Specialty show. Once a trophy is retired, re-offered legs on the award begin anew.

The current mementos are 4" Custom Die Cast Antique Gold/Brass Medals. A complete listing of the National Specialty Club trophies and sponsors will be published in the catalog.

Please note: Only PBGVCA members in good standing at the time of the specialty are eligible to be awarded Club Trophies.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace, Team, Pack or Three Generations Pedigree Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

NOTE: Accordion gating or similar perimeter fencing will be used.

NOTE: The Annual Show Chairman, Judges' Hospitality Chairman, and Judges' Transportation Chairman may not handle in Conformation at the Specialty Shows, although dogs owned or co-owned by them may be exhibited in Conformation by others. The Assistant Show Chairman may handle only dogs they own or co-own at the Annual Regional and National Specialties. These people may enter & show in any of the companion or performance events (obedience, rally, agility, etc.)

GENERAL OBEDIENCE & RALLY ENTRY RULES & INFORMATION

- The term “dog” refers to either dog or bitch in both Obedience and Rally.
- Qualifying scores are required for all trophies and rosettes in the regular classes. Qualifying scores are not required for prizes in Non-Regular classes.
- Non-Regular classes are not eligible for the Special Obedience Trial trophies, nor will qualifying scores be awarded AKC legs or points towards Obedience Trial Championships.
- OBEDIENCE & RALLY MOVE-UPS WILL BE ACCEPTED ACCORDING TO AKC REGULATIONS.
- **AKC Refund Policy - Withdrawals** after the event's closing date and time due to a change of judge must receive a full refund (no fee is paid to the AKC). Females in season must be fully refunded if withdrawn after closing and no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The Club may retain a processing fee as specified in the premium list.
- **PBGVCA Refund Policy** - PBGVCA will retain \$10 (for expenses) from the first entry of a bitch entered in obedience, rally or agility, that is withdrawn due to being in season. If the bitch is on site, verification must be made by the Show Chairman or Chairman's designee. A veterinarian letter, on the practice's letterhead, will be accepted if submitted within the time frame designated in the AKC policy above.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The PBGVCA will hold a NOHS event at both the Regional and National specialties on **Thursday & Saturday**. Please check the box on your dog's entry form if you are eligible and wish to enter this special **Owner-Handled Best of Breed** competition.

There is no additional fee for this competition.

Online entrants – Please check the Owner Handler Eligible box, or write ‘NOHS’ in the Additional Classes box.

Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

PUPPY & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Handler eligibility requirements for Sweepstakes Classes

Professional handlers may not handle in Puppy or Veteran Sweepstakes classes unless they are breeder of record on the dog, or a club member who is owner or co-owner of the dog.
Adopted, Annual Meeting of PBGVCA, April 5, 2013.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Entry fee \$28.00 The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all PBGVs, 6 months and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Entry fee to be paid in addition to the Regular Class entry fee. All puppy entries in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Breed Class. The Sweepstakes class should be shown as an Additional Class on the same entry form used to enter the dog or bitch in a Regular Class.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Entry fee \$28.00. The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all PBGVs, seven years of age and older on the day of the show. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Breed Class. The Veteran Sweepstakes class should be shown as an Additional Class on the same entry form used to enter the dog or bitch in a Regular Class. **Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes.**

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 First Place wins in an Open class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the AKC National Championship competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry on the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Notice: Juniors who win a third Novice Class with competition present may transfer their entry into the Open Class provided that the transfer is made at the Show Secretary's desk at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION

Entry fee \$28.00 The PBGVCA will offer Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competitions at both the Regional and National specialties on **Thursday & Saturday**. Entry can be made using the regular AKC Entry Form. Please designate "4-6 Month" in the Dog Show Class box. The AKC Litter Registration number can be used. The 4-6 Month Puppy Class will NOT be divided by sex. A Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex will be selected from the entrants in the class.

Please Note: Per AKC Rules, Professional Handlers and their assistants may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" and will not compete for awards. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, members of their household, or their assistants may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Minors under 18 with amateur status who reside with professional handlers or their assistants may personally exhibit dogs and compete for awards in this competition.

TRIATHLETE AND BEGINNER TRIATHLETE COMPETITION 3/31 to 4/6/2026

In an effort to show the natural abilities and versatility of our little hounds, PBGVCA will hold its 11th annual Triathlon competition during the 2026 Asheville NC Regional and National specialties. The Triathlon was started to encourage PBGV owners to try training their PBGVs and to participate in companion and performance events. It has been a huge success. Owners and their PBGVs are having fun training and finding camaraderie with fellow competitors.

There will be two levels of Triathlon Awards available, the **Triathlete Award** and **Beginner Triathlete Award**. For the Triathlete Award your PBGV needs to qualify in three different (agility, obedience, rally, scent work) companion/performance disciplines. For the Beginner Triathlete Award your PBGV must enter three different disciplines and qualify in two of them. With the exception that one of those qualifying disciplines for the Beginner Triathlete can be exchanged for one of the following (only one) CGC, CGCA, CGCU, Fast CAT, any of the Trick Dog titles offered. Qualifying scores and titles must be earned during the 2026 Regional and National events. Each PBGV achieving the Beginner Triathlete or Triathlete Award will receive a prize for earning that award.

DISCIPLINES AND CLASSES THAT COUNT TOWARD THE TRIATHLON

Agility – Any qualifying score in the Regional/National Agility trials will count towards a Triathlete Award. Regular or Preferred height.

Obedience – Any qualifying score in the Regional/National Obedience trials will count towards a Triathlete Award. With the following exceptions: Beginner Novice only counts toward the Beginner Triathlete. Veteran's obedience class for dogs age 7 or older must score a 170 or higher to count towards the regular Triathlete Award.

Rally – Any qualifying score in the Regional/National Rally trials will count towards the Triathlete Award.

Scent Work – Any qualifying score in the Regional/National Scent Work trials will count towards a Triathlete Award.

Hunt – A qualifying score in the National Hunt Test will count towards the Triathlete Award.

Passing the Hunting Instinct Test will only count for the Beginner Triathlete Award.

CGC, CGCA, CGCU, Trick Dog – Any CGC title, Trick Dog title qualifying run can count as one of your three qualifying disciplines towards the Beginner Triathlete Award.

TRIATHLON RULES

Regular Triathlon PBGVs must enter at least 3 different disciplines and qualify in 3. For the Beginner Triathlon PBGVs they must enter at least three different disciplines and qualify or receive a title in two. **Beginner Triathletes can substitute one of their disciplines with an entry in any CGC or trick dog, event.** If your PBGV only qualifies in two different disciplines no matter what disciplines you're qualifying scores came from your award will be Beginner Triathlete. Only qualifying scores from the 2026 PBGVCA Regional and National will count towards the Triathlon Awards.

Your PBGV can only compete in a class they are eligible for under AKC rules. Spayed, neutered, and PAL registered PBGVs are eligible to compete in the Triathlon. No additional cost to compete in the Triathlon. You and your dog's name will be printed in the national catalog as being entered in the Triathlon.

You must declare you are competing for a Triathlete award and list the classes you will be competing in by March 11, 2026 on the Triathlon entry form. The Triathlon form will also be in the premium list and online at www.pbgv.org. Click the Triathlon link on the left-hand side of the 2025 PBGVCA National event information. NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.**

RETURNED CHECKS will be charged a \$35.00 collection fee. The returned check must be paid with CASH at the Show Secretary's desk or office **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring. **No post-dated** checks will be accepted. **TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.**

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. **NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made. **An administrative fee of \$3.00** will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries. **ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
