## Sunday ♦ Travel Day

After an early start, we'll arrive in Plymouth, Massachusetts - America's Hometown. We'll check into the John Carver Inn, located in the heart of Plymouth within walking distance to shopping and the waterfront. This historic Inn was built on the site of the original Pilgrim settlement. Dinner tonight is included. (D)

## Monday ♦ Duxbury/Plymouth

After an included breakfast at the Inn, we'll meet our guide and head to the Alden House in Duxbury, Massachusetts, founded in 1637 and named by Myles Standish after Duxbury Woods near his hometown in England. Standish and John Alden were the first settlers here, Alden eventually building his home in 1680, where he and his wife, Priscilla Mullins, farmed and raised 10 children. From there, we'll move on to the oldest maintained cemetery in the US, where Standish and many well-known Pilgrims are buried. After lunch on your own along the waterfront in Plymouth, we'll tour Plimoth Plantation, a recreation of the first permanent European settlement in Southern New England. For dinner this evening, we'll join the costumed interpreters here for a traditional turkey dinner with all the fixings! (B, D)

## Tuesday ♦ Plymouth/Hyannis

This morning after breakfast, we'll meet our local guide to hear tales of the historic sites we'll visit today: the Plimoth Grist Mill, Hedge House, Coles Hill, the Massasoit Statue, the Immigrant Monument, Howland House, Spooner House, the Pilgrim sarcophagus and the Mayflower Society. After a photo stop at Plymouth Rock, the traditional landing site of the *Mayflower*, we'll take the Lobster Tales Cruise out of Plymouth Harbor to learn what the Wampanoags taught the Pilgrims about harvesting food from the ocean. After lunch on our own, we'll head to Pilgrim Hall Museum, our nation's oldest operating museum, which houses an exceptional collection of Pilgrim artifacts.

This evening we'll check into the Holiday Inn Hyannis for a 3-night stay. Dinner is included this evening. (B, D)

## Wednesday ♦ Provincetown

We'll start our full day of touring by traveling historic Route 6A, a scenic byway that winds past hundreds of historic structures on its way to the Cape Cod National Seashore, our first stop. Our guide will entertain us with stories of Corn Hill, First Encounter Beach, Pilgrim Spring, and the Pilgrim's first landing site, Provincetown, where we'll visit the Pilgrim Monument and the Provincetown Museum, which offers a recreation of a 19<sup>th</sup> century sea captain's parlor and his quarters at sea. You'll have time on your own for lunch and browsing the unique shops. Dinner is included this evening. (B, D)

## Thursday ♦ Hyannis/Sandwich

Today will find us visiting Hyannis, Sandwich, Barnstable and Yarmouth, towns originally settled in 1639 by people wishing to own land away from the Plymouth settlement or those unhappy living with the Boston-area Puritans. Salt hay from the marshes was used to roof their houses and feed their cattle. We'll take a 1-hour Hyannis Harbor cruise for a waterfront view of the Kennedy compound. There will be time to browse Main Street in Hyannis and enjoy lunch on our own. This afternoon we'll visit the Sandwich Glass Museum in Sandwich, where a small farming community was transformed into one of the world's most respected manufacturers of 19<sup>th</sup> glass. We'll watch as molten glass is blown and pressed into exquisite designs. Dinner tonight is included at the 300-year old Dan'l Webster Inn. (B, D)

## Friday ♦ Home

After breakfast, we'll depart for home with many fond memories and a better understanding of one of the most historic and culturally significant places in our nation. (B)
