CC&R REMINDER

The Board has received inquiries regarding the CC&R stipulations defining who may reside in the homes of Villa Monterey 2 and what constitutes an occasional visit. Answers are as follows: At least one resident occupant in 80% of the Lots/Units shall be 55 years of age or older; and the remaining occupants shall be at least 40 years of age. No permanent resident under the age of 40 is permitted. "

Occasional Visits (as defined by Article I) by underage persons are allowed. Caregivers and other home assistance personnel shall be permitted in accordance with applicable State and Federal laws.

- (H) "Member" means the owner/owners of record of any Parcel within Villa Monterey, Unit Two.
- (I) "Occasional Visit" means a visit of not more than ninety (90) days per year, the ninety (90) day timeframe shall be deemed to begin on the first day of the visit.
- (M) "Resident" means the person or persons occupying a home within Villa Monterey, Unit Two for more than 90 days
