- **Meaningful interaction and collaboration** between travelers and your counterparts will provide the chance to explore Peru's libraries to get a better understanding of their successes in meeting their specific missions; any innovations they have developed; the major challenges/issues they are dealing with in their libraries; and to identify potential collaboration/partnerships.
- Sit down and **talk to your counterparts** about some of the major challenges facing Peruvian libraries and the innovations happening in Peru today.

Focus on the community

- Giving back and engaging with the local community is an important part of your journey.
- Spend time visiting a local non-profit or other humanitarian organization in Cusco such as the **Orphanage for Girls**.
