### IV. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

Motion to approve minutes from the November 21, 2024, meeting by **Jonathan Bierman**, second by Ross Totten. Approved.

#### V. Treasurer's Report

### a. Operating Funds

• Checking Account Balance: \$42,273.44 (as of 3/26/25) with \$920 pending.

## b. Reserve Funds

- Money Market Account Balance: \$35,574.08 (as of 2/28/25).
- Total Cash Balance: \$77,767.52

#### c. Delinquencies

- \$1,895.00 owed by 6 homes as of 3/26/25.
- The board will continue outreach to remaining delinquent accounts.

#### d. Reserve Transfer

 Motion to transfer \$11,500 to reserves as budgeted by Jake Koors. Second by Dave Sladek. Unanimously approved.

#### VI. Old Business

## a. Bylaw Amendment: Quorum & Board Member Terms

- Discussion continued from 2024 proposal to reduce quorum and move to staggered 2-year board terms.
- Approx. 30–40% of homeowners participated previously.
- No set timeline but agreed to initiate renewed outreach effort.
- Action Item: Jonathan Bierman to share the list of participants and coordinate communication push.

#### **VII. New Business**

#### a. 2024 Federal & State Tax Returns

- Returns completed by GLM. Motion to ratify by **Jonathan Bierman**, second by Manny Calvillo. Unanimously approval.
- No taxes due or refunded.

### b. Insurance Policy Renewal

- Current AM quote at \$6,500; negotiated to \$3,600.
- State Farm provided a competitive bid at ~\$2,900 with similar coverage (slightly lower Medical Liability, including terrorism coverage).
- Medical liability increased from \$5K to \$10K.
- Motion to approve State Farm policy by Dave Sladek second by Jonathan Bierman.
  Unanimously approved.

#### c. 2025 Events Schedule

- Community Garage Sale Will continue with Cornerstone. Planned for late June, will continue to track when they post the date.
- **Block Party** Targeting end of August or September. Dates to be finalized for the next meeting.
- Fishing Derby / Golf Outing Both are potential events; to be discussed further.

## d. 2025 Capital Project Planning

- 2024 focused on mulch and cul-de-sacs.
- Plan for phased tree removal and replacement, especially on King James Ct and King James Ave.
  - o Tree removal: ~\$1,300 per island
  - o Stump grinding: \$390
  - Replacement (3 trees): \$1,200
  - Delivery & planting: \$700
  - Evergreen total: ~\$3,600; Deciduous: ~\$4,500
- Davey Tree to handle removal, Wasco for planting.
- Discussion on watering solutions for first-year plantings (hydrant attachment or green gators).
- Action Item: Jonathan Bierman to gather 2025 pricing for tree work, monument area, and watering options.
- **Monument Alternative:** \$2,600 quote to remove large section and seed with grass was not favored.
- **Pond Maintenance:** Rip rap on East edge discussed. Planned with McCloud for mid-April. Decided to hold off.

## **Speeding Concerns**

- Ross Totten raised ongoing issues, particularly near bus stops.
- Coordination with Jayme and Ryan Bongard noted.
- Possibility of communication to residents or action via city council.

### Action Items:

- Ross to draft messages to residents about speeding concerns and gauge interest in a petition.
- Ross to gather resident feedback on intersection at Foxfield and King Edward (possible roundabout or 4-way stop).
- o Continue monitoring and reporting speeding issues.
