**Treasurer's Report (Marie Bush): **

- Banking Resolutions: Increased ACH processing limit from \$5,000 to \$10,000 per month.
- Invoices: Three invoices from Allegiance need review by Darren and Levi due to discrepancies.
- Bridge Accounting: Need to reconcile accounting for the bridge project due to discrepancies and unpaid invoices.
- Delinquency Tax Report: Delinquency tax report is printed out.
- Tax Sale: Discussed the possibility of tax sales and the cost/process with a lawyer.

**Property Tax Re-evaluation Request (Dylan McConnell): **

- Dylan McConnell believes his property is overvalued, particularly the cabin structure.
- He missed the deadline for contesting the evaluation this year.
- He requested a waiver of penalty and interest due to bringing the issue to the meeting.
- The board cannot decide on the evaluation; it must go through the listers.
- The listers will re-evaluate the property in the coming spring.
- The board agreed to waive the penalty and interest.

**Newport Update (Rick Ufford Chase): **

- Mayor Chase provided an overview of Newport's downtown revitalization efforts.
- The city is working on a new master plan with a focus on housing, commercial development, and public amenities.
- Tax increment financing (TIF) is being considered to fund public infrastructure improvements.
- The city is seeking input from surrounding towns and villages through a survey.
- The board expressed support for Newport's efforts and offered suggestions.

**Solar Field Project: **

- A 30-acre solar field is planned for the Raboin property.
- The zoning board and select board missed the deadline to submit comments to the Public Utility Commission (PUC).
- The zoning bylaws do not address solar projects.
- The board discussed the project's benefits, impacts, and potential conditions.
- They agreed to meet with a representative from Northland Solar LLC next Tuesday.
- The Zoning board will contact the League of Cities and Towns to clarify their options.
- The board asked the Town Clerk to notify neighboring landowners about the upcoming meeting.
- The board will investigate the possibility of the vast trail being impacted.

Sign Orders:

• Financials for the Treasurer were approved and signed by the Board.

VLT farm project follow-up:

**Vermont Land Trust (Carrie O'Brien) **

- Vermont Land Trust seeks a letter of support from the town for a Clean Water State Revolving Fund project.
- The funds would be used to acquire the Farm in question formerly Highland Cattle Farm.
- The plan is to improve the farm, add water quality protections to the easement, and lease it to a qualified farmer.
- The board discussed the implications of a river corridor easement and the types of farming that could occur.
- The board voted to approve the letter of support.

Minutes from September 23, 2025:

• Minutes from September 23, 2025, were approved and signed by the Board unanimously.

Road Commissioner Updates (Levi Booska & Darren Pion):

- Valley Road repairs are complete.
- Carter Road will be starting on Monday.
- Discussion about shim coating one side of the road.
- The board discussed a culvert issue on Eden Road and a request for gravel on Guyette Road.
- The board will investigate the possibility of putting gravel on Guyette Road.

Other Business:

- The board agreed to waive the penalty and interest for a property tax payment that was less than one day late.
- The board discussed equipment maintenance and replacement.
- The board discussed ordering salt for the winter.

** Conclusions: **

- * The meeting covered a wide range of topics, including financial matters, property tax issues, economic development, and infrastructure projects.
- * The board is actively engaged in addressing the town's needs and concerns.
- * The board is committed to working with other organizations and municipalities to achieve common goals.
