

# Trains of New England

October 9 - 15, 2021

7 Days, 6 Nights

## Saturday ♦ Travel Day

Today we head for Andover, Massachusetts where this evening we'll check into the Doubletree Inn and have dinner on our own at the hotel.

## Sunday ♦ Boston, MA

After an included breakfast at the Doubletree, we'll travel to Boston and meet our local guide at the Quincy Market to begin our riding tour of the beautiful brownstones and unique architecture of Beacon Hill and Back Bay. We'll see Boston Common, the site of the Boston Massacre in 1775, the Old Statehouse, and the Old North Church, where Robert Newman climbed the steeple to hang the lanterns to signal Paul Revere that the British were coming.

Our guide will recommend some great restaurants for lunch on our own. After lunch, we'll visit the Charlestown Navy Yard where the USS Constitution ("Old Ironsides") is docked.

In the late afternoon we'll head back to Quincy Market where over 100 shops, restaurants, and artisans offer a unique shopping and dining experience. Dinner this evening is on your own at Quincy Market. (B)

## Monday ♦ Ogunquit, ME

After an included breakfast at our hotel, we'll board the Amtrak Downeaster to Wells, Maine where we'll meet our local guide for a tour of Kennebunkport, which includes a ride past the George HW Bush estate at Walker's Point.

Lunch will be on your own in Dock Square where fishing boats unload their catch daily.

After lunch we'll check in at the Aspinquid Resort in Ogunquit, Maine and enjoy a classic Downeast lobsterbake or barbecued chicken dinner with all the local fixin's.

## Tuesday ♦ Lincoln, NH

After a leisurely continental breakfast at our hotel, we'll ride the rails from Maine to New Hampshire on the

Conway Scenic Railroad. We'll pass through the spectacular Crawford Notch - past sheer bluffs, steep ravines, cascading brooks, mountain vistas, across Frankenstein Trestle and Willey Brook Bridge to Crawford Station. A box lunch is included on the train.

After disembarking from the train, we'll ride through the White Mountains to Fadden's General Store, family owned since 1896. We'll tour their maple sugar house and sample some maple goodies. Then we'll board the Café Lafayette Dinner Train and enjoy a five course dinner in the beautifully restored Pullman dining cars. Later, we'll check into the Mountain Club on Loon in Lincoln, New Hampshire for the night.

## Wednesday ♦ Lincoln, NH

This morning we'll meet our guide and head to Lake Winnepesaukee for a cruise aboard the Mount Washington. Lunch is on your own in the delightful lakeside town of Wolfeboro, the oldest summer resort in America. After lunch we'll tour the Wright Museum, known for its exhibits of aircraft and tanks used in WWII. For dinner, we'll arrive at Meredith Station to board the Winnepesaukee Railroad Turkey Dinner Train and enjoy a hot roast turkey dinner carved table side as we watch the scenery glide by. (B,D)

## Thursday ♦ Stockbridge, MA

Today we'll motor through Vermont to the Berkshires and the Publik House for an included lunch. Then we'll stop in at Hemmings Automobilia, a filling station and auto museum displaying 27 vintage cars. Next, it's on to Bennington Apple Barn, a 300-acre apple orchard with some of the most spectacular fall foliage in Southern Vermont. To top off the day, the Country Bake Shop will serve everyone a complimentary slice of their famous apple pie a la mode!

We'll check into our hotel in the Berkshires early in the evening and enjoy dinner on our own at the hotel. (B,L)

## Friday ♦ Stockbridge / Home

This morning we'll meet our guide at the Red Lion Inn for a Fall Foliage Leaf-Peeper Tour through the scenic Berkshires and visit the summer "cottages" of steel magnate Andrew Carnegie and Harley Proctor, founder of Proctor & Gamble. We'll also tour the picture postcard town of Stockbridge, home of Norman Rockwell and Tanglewood, the summer home of the Boston Symphony Orchestra. We'll see many of Rockwell's original works on display in the Rockwell Museum. After lunch on your own in town, we'll depart for home. (B)
