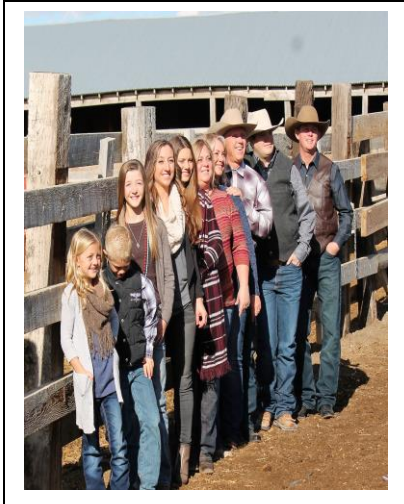

celebrating 70 years of
Professional Rodeo.**

Pro Rodeo Hall of Fame inductee D.A. Swanny Kerby and his Wife Verda Kerby produced their first professional rodeo in Grand Junction, Colorado in 1949. Swanny brought some of the first rodeos to Utah and for over 50 years produced quality PRCA rodeos throughout the Western United States. Swanny and Verda’s Son Bud Kerby worked side by side with them and when they retired Bud and his wife Evelyn took over the family business. Bud, a past saddle bronc rider and pick up man, was highly respected as one of the best bucking horse men in the industry. His love and knowledge of the bucking horses made the Bar T breeding program one of the most sought after and recognized horse herds in the world.

Bar T Rodeo has taken horses and bulls to the National Finals Rodeo every year since 1959. In 2000 Bar T started their own bull breeding program with the help of Son In-law Jeff and Daughter Wendie Flitton.

In October 2010 Bud passed away suddenly leaving boots to fill. At that time his wife Evelyn, Jeff, Wendie and Cody Flitton, along many other family members stepped up to help carry on the legacy.

Today Bar T Rodeo celebrates 5 Generations of carrying on the tradition and the love of rodeo.

The Bar T Rodeo family maintains a high standard for quality of livestock and rodeos for the industry. Working hard in maintaining a herd that gives each cowboy a fair opportunity at a payoff check each time the gate is opened.
