### RCIA/OCIA: Rite of Election & Call in Continuing Conversion

The Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion will take place on Saturday, February 17th at the Cathedral of the Madeleine.

The Rite of Election affirms the Catechumens' readiness for the sacraments of initiation. They will write their name in the Book of Elect, expressing their desire and intent to celebrate Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. They are called "the Elect" from this point, indicating they have been chosen, elected, by God and the Church. This is the 2nd major step in the RCIA/OCIA process.

The Call to Continuing Conversion for the Candidates (those baptized in a non-Catholic Christian church) gives Bishop Solis the opportunity to greet them and to ask their sponsors to affirm them. Then Bishop Solis invites the Candidates to join in full communion with the Church and to hear the Lord's call to continuing conversion.

Please pray for our Catechumens and Candidate as they continue their journey towards the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil.
