



SEWER DISTRICT -JOB POSTING-

COLLECTION SYSTEM SUPERINTENDENT

This position requires a candidate that will promote a positive and effective workplace through a collaborative approach with staff and has a thorough knowledge of sanitary sewer system construction, operation, maintenance and rehabilitation practices. The Collection System Superintendent reports to the Logan County Water Pollution Control District Director. In addition to direct oversight of the Collections Group this position will perform various administrative tasks such as preparing annual operating and capital budgets, reviewing and approving invoices from vendors and contractors, preparing regulatory and operational reports as well as providing relevant safety and skills training to staff.

Minimum requirements include prior experience in construction, operation, maintenance and rehabilitation of sanitary sewers. At least two years of supervisory or leadership experience. An Ohio EPA Class II Collection Operator License or Class II Wastewater Operator License is required. A candidate with a Class I Wastewater Collection Operator License or Class I Wastewater Treatment Operator License may be considered for the position with a requirement to obtain a Class II license within a specific time period. Must possess a valid Ohio Driver License with a clean driving record and maintain qualifications for driving on county business at all times. A minimum of a Class B CDL with tanker and air brake endorsements is required within 18 months of hire.

Logan County offers a competitive annual salary for this position of \$74,069–\$80,898 (\$35.61 - \$38.89 per hour) depending on qualifications and experience.

The selected candidate must pass a criminal background check and drug screening. All positions are subject to a probationary period of 12 months. The County provides an excellent benefits package that include 2 weeks of vacation after the 1st year and regular increases thereafter based on years of service, sick leave, health insurance and prescription drug plan with options for supplemental (vision/dental) insurance and a pension program through Ohio Public Employees Retirement System.
