

Position: **Water Treatment Chief Operator**
 Warren County Water & Sewer Department, Lebanon, Ohio

Job Responsibilities: The Warren County Water and Sewer Department seeks a Water Treatment Chief Operator. The Chief Operator will manage, operate, maintain, and serve as the Operator of Record (ORC) of the County's water treatment plants, booster stations, and elevated storage facilities. The County operates two treatment plants that are designed to finished water capacities of 13.7 and 10.3 million gallons per day (mgd). The facilities treat groundwater from aquifers along the Little Miami and near the Great Miami Rivers. With assistance from the Operations Superintendent and other Chief Operator(s) this person will direct staff that operates and maintains the treatment plants, nine elevated storage tanks, and four booster pump stations.

Preferred Qualifications: Completion of secondary education and one year work experience as a supervisor in a treatment facility. Ohio EPA Class III Water Supply Certification or the ability to obtain a Class III certification within 12 months of employment.
