DESCRIPTION: Attractive Colt recurve. Designed and made for Colt by Bob Lee and Wing archery. The Huntsman Hi-Power was Colt's top of the line hunting bow. Bubinga Riser with contrasting laminations. Forest green fiberglass limbs. Very comfortable pistol grip. No delamination; limbs are straight. Tip overlays are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing.

There are two noticeable flaws in this bow: 1) there is a small scrape in the riser at the top of the bow specs, and 2) there is a spot of fiberglass that is "peeling" and some scratches on the back limb just above the riser (see pic on last page). The scratch lines were not stress cracks but scratches in the fiberglass. The entire top back limb was re-stained/refinished. The green is a darker green than the rest of the limbs.

A few other minor scratches and scuffs here and there. One of the decals on the limbs is original, and one was considerably faded and replaced with a reproduction. Overall, this is a really attractive bow that still shoots really well.

Were it not for the flaws, this bow would be priced considerably higher.
