

A request by the Board of Trustees to authorize them to enter into a covenantal building use agreement with Family Christian Church of God. The Board was approached by a representative of Family Christian Church of God regarding building use for their congregation. The primary space utilized will be Fellowship Hall on the lower level, if approved, on Sundays from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm. Preliminary discussion and negotiations have already begun and the Trustees would like to proceed with a covenantal agreement.
