Please note that your December utility bill (for November activity) will reflect an **Equal Pay** amount through April until the meters are read again.

Propane Tank Safety - Use a broom instead of a shovel when clearing snow off the tank or around the exposed piping, regulator, gauges, or tubing.

When clearing the roof, avoid shoveling snow onto exposed piping around the propane regulator near the building or onto the propane tank and piping, as well as any meters or other piping that may be in use.


