Why is the Catholic Church such a strong voice for life?

Saint John Paul II stated in Evangelium Vitae, 28 in 1995

"...we are facing an enormous and dramatic clash between good and evil, death and life, the 'culture of death' and the 'culture of life'. We find ourselves not only faced with but necessarily in the midst of this conflict: we are all involved and we all share in it, with the inescapable responsibility of choosing to be unconditionally pro-life."

*Pope John Paul II, Evangelium vitae, (Vatican City: Libreria Editrice Vaticana, 1995), no. 28. MONTH 2-DEVELOPING BABY-"I'm dancing!"

This baby is making progress in developing all of her external features and internal organs. Her brain is functioning at 40 days. Her mother can hear her heartbeat now on an ultrasonic stethoscope. Baby-teeth buds are present at 6 ½ weeks. The central nervous system is functioning and 40 muscle sets begin their first exercises. From this moment, this beautiful baby grows and refines her body. But everything she needs to survive after birth is already present by the end of the eighth week. She is now called a "fetus" -a Latin word meaning "little one". An ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring, flip, and jump--her first dance steps!
