The initial installment must be a minimum of \$30, which immediately activates a 5-year membership. Installment plan billing is conducted quarterly – October 1st, December 1st, March 1st, and June 1st. During the fiscal initiated, lifetime membership must be paid in full by August 31st. If you do not complete the installment plan by August 31st, any amount in excess of \$30 will be posted as a credit and you may apply this credit towards an eligible RIVHSA purchase by September 30th. After September 30th, any unused portion of the credit will be forfeited. Membership fees are non-refundable.*
