A BIT OF SOUTHERN HISTORY - from Chuck Smith

If you are a true Southerner, and someone said that they were going to the "Pig" to get something, you knew exactly what they meant. They were going to the Piggly Wiggly grocery store for some needed items.

Piggly Wiggly was founded by Clarence Saunders in September of 1916, in Memphis TN, and was the originator of various grocery store features.

Piggly Wiggly was the first "self-service" grocery store. At the time, stores did not allow customers to gather their own goods. Instead, a customer would give a list of items to a clerk, who would collect them throughout the store. Piggly Wiggly introduced the innovation of allowing customers to walk through the store, gathering their goods themselves. This was known as the "self-service" format, and was patented by Saunders in 1917.

In 1937, Piggly Wiggly became the first to provide shopping carts for its customers. They were also the first company to use check-out lanes for payment.

At its peak in 1932, the company operated 2600 stores and posted annual sales in excess of \$180 million.

When asked about the origin of the company name, Saunders was reluctant to explain. His response when asked why he had chosen such an unusual name for his company was "So people will ask that very question".
