Ordinance O-2018-27

AN ORDINANCE HIRING JONATHAN NEALAN AS A FULL TIME POLICE OFFICER FOR AMELIA VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Mayor of Amelia Village after conferring with the Police Chief, has recommended the hiring of Jonathan Nealan as a full time police officer for Amelia Village, and;

WHEREAS, The Council of Amelia Village concurs in the appointment of Jonathan Nealan as a full time Amelia police officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that;

SECTION I. Jonathan Nealan is hereby employed as a full time police officer of Amelia Village, effective July 23, 2018 at a starting salary of \$18.14 per hour.

SECTION II. This appointment is contingent upon Jonathan Nealan passing pre-employment medical and/or psychological examinations and drug screening to ensure that Mr. Wade is physically and mentally able to perform the duties of police officer.

SECTION III. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is that the Police Department of Amelia Village has recently lost several police officers and this appointment will allow the Village to provide the necessary police protection to the citizens of the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
