

**Town of Stratton
Selectmen's Meeting
March 22, 2021**

Present: Selectmen: Larry Bills – Vice Chair, Chris Liller, Greg Marcucci and Kevin Robinson, and Kent Young – Clerk.

Larry Bills called the meeting to order at 7:30pm at the Stratton Town Office. Orders were reviewed and signed.

Modifications to the Agenda: No modifications were made.

Road Crew Issues: New Truck: The Road Foreman stated that the new truck should be ready in about one month. **Yearly Bids:** The Selectmen agreed to open the yearly bids on May 10. Paving bids will be asked for, but contingent on the receipt of a grant. **FLEET permits:** The Selectmen reviewed overweight permit applications from Fuller Sand and Gravel, Inc., David Chaves Excavating, Inc. and Frost Wells and Pumps, Inc.. Chris Liller moved to approve said permits. Kevin Robinson seconded – all concurred and Larry Bills signed the permits.

LEMP: The Selectmen reviewed the Local Emergency Management Plan and agreed to re-adopt it as submitted. Kevin Robinson so moved. Greg Marcucci seconded – all concurred. Chris Liller signed to certify it to meet Vermont National Incident Management Systems (NIMS) requirements and current LEMP Implementation guidance. Larry Bills signed the re-adoption form as Vice-Chair.

DVFiber: The Selectmen considered re-appointment of Betsy Wadsworth as Representative and Alyson Peterson and Candie Bernard as alternates to the Deerfield Valley Communications Union District. Kevin Robinson so moved. Chris Liller seconded – all concurred.

Minutes: Greg Marcucci moved to approve the Selectmen's Minutes and Liquor Control Board minutes of March 8, 2021. Kevin Robinson seconded. All concurred and the minutes were approved.

Town Office Maintenance: The Clerk stated that he had requested Southworth Electrical to order additional florescent lights for the office; however, Southworth Electrical asked if the Town would like to upgrade the fixtures to LED. He recommended that if so, we could do about 13 fixtures initially and then upgrade others as needed in the future. The Selectmen agreed and would like to pursue any Efficiency VT initiatives that may be available. The Clerk agreed to inform Southworth Electrical of their decision.

Adjourn: Chris Liller motioned to adjourn at 7:55p.m.. Greg Marcucci seconded. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned.
