

## Town of Baldwin, Maine SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2020, 6:30 P.M.

1. Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:35 PM by Jim Dolloff.

2. Review/ Approve minutes

Jim Dolloff requested a motion to accept and approve October 20, 2020 minutes. Dwight Warren seconded the motion; no discussion. Selectmen voted 2-0 to approve the minutes.

3. Review/ Approve warrant

Jim Dolloff requested a motion to accept and approve November 3rd, 2020 warrant. Dwight Warren seconded the motion; no discussion. Selectmen voted 2-0 to approve the warrant.

- <u>Gate Repair to the Playground</u>: Need to talk to Brian to repair playground fence. Having issues after hours on the playground.
- Wentworth Road trees: MMA legal responded to the Wentworth tree issue via email: "The town's legally obligated to keep town ways safe and convenient, which would include the duty to remove rotting trees that pose a road safety problem (23 MRS § 3651). State law authorizes the removal of trees and brush within the town's right of way for this purpose, but prevents the removal of ornamental or public shade trees, or trees planted for profit (i.e. apple trees that are part of an orchard) (23 MRS § 2702, 30-A MRS § 3291). Therefore, we advise that these trees should not be cut unless they pose a safety threat to the travelling public or pedestrians, or they are impacting the municipality's ability to repair or maintain the road."

- Outdoor security cameras will meet with the camera company.
- Gymp microphone needed for meeting recordings Jim mentioned to try the camera closer to the Board to improve voice recording. Also talk to the camera company to see if they have any suggestions.
