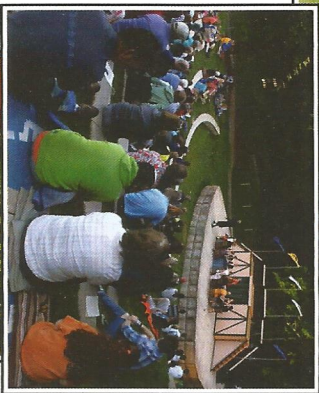
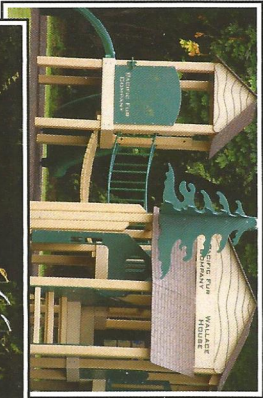


# Working for you — Working for us

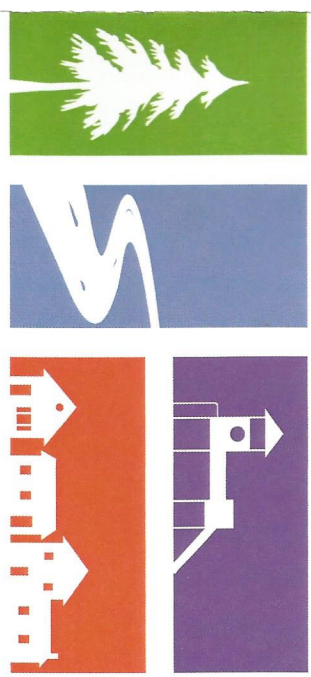
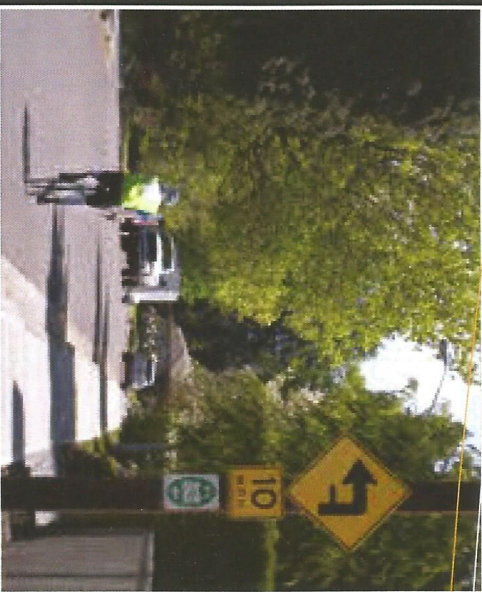
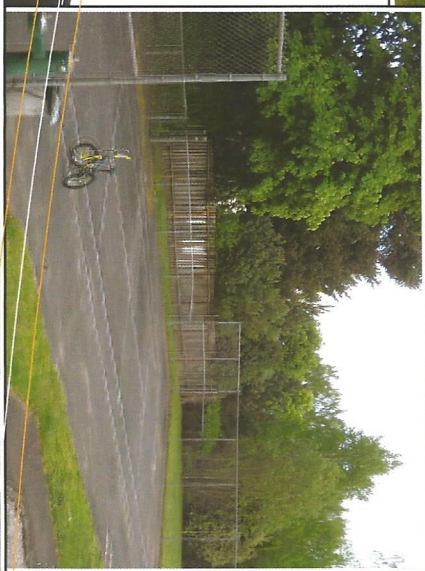
# Join Us

Meeting each month — except for the summer months of June, July, and August and the month of December — on the second Thursday.

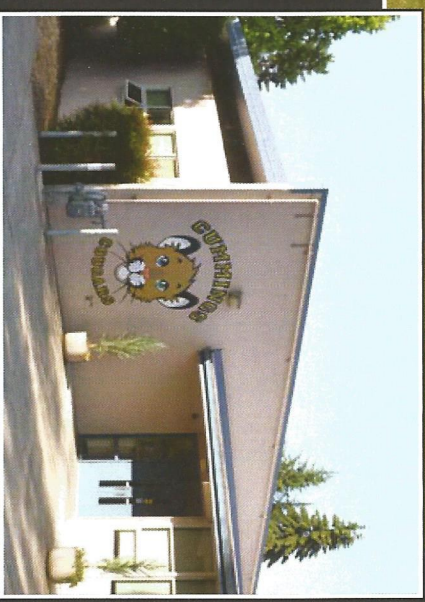
Meetings always held at the Keizer City Hall / Community Center complex from 7:00pm to about 8:30pm. Refreshments often provided.
