



## Breckinridge County Public Library News and Events Library Card Sign-Up Month

September is library card sign-up month! What better way to celebrate than by getting a library card or using your current card. Some helpful library tips:

- To check out movies, you have to be at least 18 years old
- 2 of our two day movies and 2 of our seven day movies can be checked out on one card
- Under the age of 18, you must have a parent or guardian sign an Internet Policy before being able to access the computers
- \$0.20 per page to print in black and white. \$1.00 per page to print in color
- Fines for books and audio books are \$0.05 per day per book. Fines for movies is \$2.00 per day per movie.
- Overdue balances of \$10.00 or more, than you cannot check out anything until the balance is under \$10.00
- As long as you know the last 6 digits of your card number, you do not need to have your card to check out items.
- To renew, you do not have to bring your items with you. You can stop by the library or call to renew your items. We just need the last 6 digits of your library card number.

On Monday, September 24 we will be having our Fandom Fanatics Festival from 5:00–6:30pm. This is an all ages program and you can dress up as your favorite character. There will be themed tables set up throughout the library that you visit. The fandoms that we know for sure that we are going to have are Harry Potter, Superheroes (Marvel & D.C.
