AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MAGNOLIA PLACE SUBDIVISION RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION, INC.

WHEREAS, the Board of the Magnolia Place Subdivision Residents Association Inc. desires to make certain revisions and amendments to its Declarations of Restrictions and it is necessary to amend its prior Articles of Incorporation, recorded with the Kentucky Secretary of State, and the Office of the Shelby County Clerk at A 9, PG 14, executed on January 22, 2001, and;

WHEREAS, these Amended Articles are necessary for purposes of permitting and otherwise allowing the corporation to consider amendments to the Declaration of Restrictions; and;

WHEREAS, the Board has carefully considered, and entered into a resolution for purposes of Amending its Articles of Incorporation for purposes of permitting it to consider and possibly revise its Declarations of Restrictions; and

WHEREAS, the Association has complied with the KRS 273.263 and has obtained the votes of 2/3 of the members of the Association to permit the filing and recording of these Amended Articles of Incorporation; and;

TO WIT: The Magnolia Place Subdivision Residents Association, Inc. hereby declares the Amended Articles of Incorporation to be as follows:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation is: MAGNOLIA PLACE SUBDIVISION RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

The corporation's duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

DEFINITIONS

As used in these <u>Amended</u> Articles of Incorporation, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

- (a) "Developer" shall mean JIL Development Company, Inc. and shall include any person, Corporation, or association to whom it may expressly assign, from time to time, any rights under these Articles of Incorporation.
- (b) "Subdivision" shall mean lots Lots 1 through 27, Lots 50-68 and Lot 85 inclusive of Magnolia Place Subdivision, Section 1 as recorded in the Office of the Shelby County Court Clerk in Plat Cabinet 5, Slide 374, and Magnolia Place Subdivision, Section 2 as recorded in the Office of the Shelby County Clerk in Plat Cabinet 6, Slide 241 and any amendments thereto.
- (c) "Declaration of Restrictions" shall mean any Declaration of Restrictions of Magnolia Place Subdivision and any amendments <u>or revisions</u> thereto.
- (d) "Residential Unit" shall mean each lot in the Subdivision, the owner of which shall become a member of the Corporation pursuant to any Declaration of Restrictions.
- (e) "Members" shall mean the record owner(s) of a residential unit.
- (f) "Record Owner(s) shall mean each person listed in a deed.

ARTICLE IV

PURPOSES

The Corporation is organized under the Kentucky Nonprofit Corporation Act, <u>KRS 273.161 through 273.400</u>, and the purposes and objects for which the Corporation is formed are (a) to promote the social welfare and serve the common good and general welfare of the owners or occupants of the Residential Units, (b) to administer and enforce the Declarations of Restrictions, and (c) to construct, operate, maintain and repair any common structure, facility, way or ground, whether owned by the Corporation or not, within the Subdivision for the use and enjoyment of members of the general public.

ARTICLE V

POWERS

In addition to all other powers the Corporation may have pursuant to the Kentucky Nonprofit Corporation Act, the Corporation shall have the power to:

- (a) Exercise and enforce any right or privilege assigned to it under the Declaration of Restrictions, and
- (b) Assess, levy and collect assessments against each Residential Unit and against members of the Corporation as provided in the Declaration of Restrictions, and
- (c) <u>To amend the Declaration of Restrictions with at least a two-thirds of the votes by</u> the members. The vote shall be by ballot provided to each member.

ARTICLE VI

INTERNAL AFFAIRS

Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, including provisions for the distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation, are:

- (a) The membership of the Corporation shall consist of the members designated from time to time in the Declaration of Restrictions, and such members shall be classified as follows:
 - (1) Class A membership shall consist of all members other than the Developer.
 (2) Class B shall consist of the Developer.
- (b) Each member shall have one vote in respect to each Residential Unit owner by such member, but the right of Class A members to vote may be exercised only in accordance with subparagraph 6(c).
- (c) Class A members shall not be entitled to exercise any vote until the earlier of: (1) April 1, 2005, or
 - (2) Such time as in Developer's sole determination, Developer or its assignce owns less than 20% of all the lots in the Subdivision, exclusive of streets, rights of way, open spaces and all common or publicly dedicated land.
- (d) (a) No part of the Corporation's net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any individual or any member of the Corporation.
- (e) (b) Upon the dissolution of final liquidation of the Corporation, any remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to one or more organizations, designed designated by the Board of Directors at that time, to be used in such manner as in the judgment of the Board of Directors will best accomplish the general purpose of the Corporation. Each of such organization shall be exempt from federal tax under the existing Internal Revenue Code.
