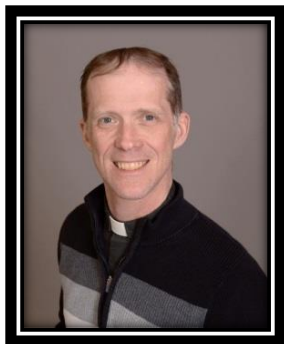

To Love One Another As Jesus loves -----  
----- *With Pastor Eric*

***“When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, “Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?” – John 21:15***

***“<sup>34</sup> I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. “– John 13:34***

In John 21, the Risen Jesus sits around the fire eating breakfast with Peter and six other disciples, and he asks Peter, “Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?” And I have always wondered what or who “these” refers to. Some commentators believe that it might be the other disciples, or maybe the catch of fish. Do you love me more than these disciples? Or more than you love this catch of fish, or fishing itself? Jesus seems to keep it rather ambiguous and up to interpretation in that moment. Perhaps John kept this question open not just for Peter’s sake but ours as well. Do you love Jesus more than anything or anyone else? Maybe it’s a question of priorities, or allegiances?

The kind of love that Jesus shares with us and asks from us is not easy to live out. When Jesus gave his disciples the command to love one another as he loved them, he did so between Judas’s betrayal and the prediction of Peter’s denial of both him (*Jesus*) and himself (*Peter*) as a disciple of Jesus. Knowing that he was going to be abandoned and betrayed to death, Jesus washed their feet and ate with them. What does one do to love like Jesus loves? Here is what I think. Firstly, to love like Jesus is to be loved by Jesus and to know and be known by that love in baptism by Spirit, word and sacrament. Secondly to love like Jesus is to be forgiven and forgiving. *“Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us.”* Life in God’s love is grace fueled with the Spirit’s breathing in with God’s forgiveness and out with forgiveness given to others. We love those who love us, but the true life in Christ is

loving those who do not love us. God is glorified in this way of loving and its benefits are reconciliation and peace.

Do I love Jesus more than anything or anyone else? However convicted I may feel or want to be, I remember that Jesus loves me first and forgives me and calls me to live a life of forgiveness not by my own power but by His gracious will. Over a lifetime I may know and be known by this reconciling, forgiving, boundless love and by God's grace embody it. ☺

Let us pray. ***Lord, whose love endures forever and remains steadfast and sure, embrace me and transform me with your love so that I may grow to know it and live it as your disciple in a world that longs for it and bring you glory. Amen.***

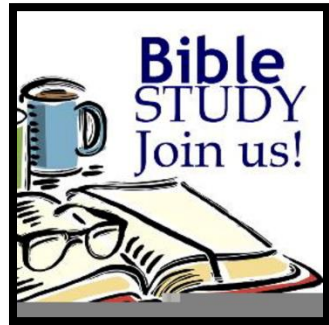
