

The Pickaway Senior Center first opened its doors, in April of 1972, under the direction of Twyla Lorentz, in the Lorentz filling station across from the fairgrounds. In 1977 Twyla retired and the Senior Center, under the direction of Wanda Hamilton, moved into a temporary location on route 22 until our present facility could be completed in late 1978. This facility was expanded in 1981, and then again in 1998 while Sue Frey was our Senior Center Director.

Today 45 years later we serve as a multipurpose Senior Center that provides all of Pickaway County with quality senior be extra special as we services. (Home Delivered CELEBRATE the Senior Meals, Transportation, Homemaking, Adult Day/ Alzheimer's Respite) Each year we serve over 1,300 Pickaway County Seniors with these services, while daily holding

### Our services are provided for seniors ages 60 and over, Monday through Friday.

#### **Adult Day Care:**

Provides relief for families caring for a loved one with dementia or Alzheimer's. This service is available Monday through Thursday from 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM. Lunch and transportation are provided.

#### **Congregate Meals:**

A hot lunch served at the Pickaway Senior Center at 11:30 AM on Monday, and at 12:00 noon Tuesday through Friday.

#### **Homemakers:**

Assistance with cleaning, laundry and running errands.
Clients must meet certain eligibility criteria.

#### **Meals on Wheels:**

A hot lunch delivered to your home five days a week.

## National Family Caregiver Support Program:

Respite and personal care, financial help with co-pays and medicine, utility bills, home repair. The care recipient must be over 60 years of age.

Supportive Services: Assistance with Medicare & Medicaid papers, HEAP and commodities paperwork.

#### **Transportation:**

Transportation for medical appointments, dialysis, and grocery shopping.
