









How Do I Give to the Church and Its Ministries

We met Erika a few years ago when she was a student. She and Zina began reading the Bible together, but they stopped because Erika had a hard time understanding that God loves her and that Jesus died for her sins. But we kept in contact with her and she babysat for us several times. In the spring, we were catching up with her, and Zina invited her and her boyfriend, Miha, to start reading the Bible with us. She is a culturally catholic, and he identified as agnostic. We were once talking about some of the Christians he knew, and he described them as the "typical Slovene Catholics - hypocritical, judgmental, and argumentative."

As we started doing the Discovery Bible Study together, it quickly became clear that God was working to draw them toward Him. Right from the beginning they were making great observations about the text, asking good questions, and were really seeking to not only understand it, but also find ways to apply it to their lives. Each week Miha was really taking meaningful applications from the Bible, and doing them. One week, he noticed that Erika was really



tired from work, and so he prayed that God would make it so she could rest the next day. Right after he prayed that, he said she got an email that her meeting for tomorrow had been canceled and so she

had the day off! He was shocked!

As we have continued to read together, they have begun praying together for each other and for various things. They have said they really feel like reading and praying together has brought them closer to one another and grown them in their relationship! They continue to grow in their understanding of the Bible, and Miha is opening up to the idea that there is a God, and that He knows and loves him. Pray for them, pray that God would continue to draw them closer to Him. Pray that he would bring them into His Kingdom. Pray that as they discover who He his, that they would share that truth with those around them.
