- Info: We had an unscheduled Bureau of Labor Standards inspection.

 - o Turnout gear is only good for 10 years. Afterwards can only be used for training.
 - o Inspection of SCBA was good and noted easy access to tools.
 - o Plugins for trucks need to be GFI.
 - o Driver training needs to be minimum EVOC or Class B. Then signoff of individual on each piece of equipment they will drive.
 - o Recommendation for new station.
 - o We have 90 days for correction, then we will receive a bill.
- **Info:** If we hire Safety Works every couple of years, then we would not see an inspection from BLS.
- **SOP:** New run sheets are posted.
- **Training:** Fire attack and hose advancement training, October 9th at 6:00.
