Job Description: The program manager will provide program management services to customer at an expert level of knowledge in DoD Cyber Security including the fields of Risk Management Framework, DIACAP Certification and Accreditation (C&A), Information Assurance Management (IAM), Computer Network Defense (CND), & Cyber Security Planning (NIST/FISMA). The PM will serve as the primary liaison for Prime and Sub-Contracting Partners with customer, and is expected to perform business process development functions.

Responsibilities:

- Serves as a POC for customer relations, acting as a SME in department-level working groups.
- Ensuring adequate program controls are applied to each task area, including scheduling, resource allocation, direction, cost quality control, report preparation, establishing and maintaining records, and resolution of customer complaints.
- Resolving quality, timeliness, and accuracy issues.
- Ensure CDRL quality prior to submission to the Government
- Adjudicating any contractor personnel performance issues with the TPOC and COR.
- Performing project management and business process development functions.
