The One Moto Show By Tom Nielsen

This year for the One Moto Show, Jen and I were asked to curate an antique-vintage motorcycle display at the show. With the help of Doug McMahon of the Oregon Vintage Motorcyclists club, we assembled 28 antique and vintage motorcycles for display.

Our goal was to bring out the individual stories of each bike: how the owner obtained the bike, what they had done to restore, modify, or customize them, and other interesting anecdotes that helped bring the bikes to life. The stories were posted on 11"x17" placards in front of each bike. The bikes were laid out by region: British, American, Japanese, and European.

In addition, we assembled educational materials and vintage photos and advertisements that were displayed as a backdrop to the bikes. Educational information included motorcycle jargon, a listing of American made motorcycle companies formed before and after 1920 (there are over a hundred), and stories of famous motorcyclists such as Thomas Laurence and his Brough Superior, Bessie Stringfield's accomplishments, and Elspeth Beard's motorcycle trip around the world.

The antique-vintage bike display was very well received, based on comments from visitors and exhibitors. Several folks expressed interest in joining our club. Other highlights of the show included motorcycle stunt riding including the Seattle Cossacks and indoor flat track racing at the Expo Center. Thanks to OTC and OVM members for bringing their bikes for display.




Meeting called to order by President James McQuiston at 7:01 pm.

New Business:


- ✓ 2024 Events


