
MARGARITAVILLE PIGEON FORGE

MARGARITAVILLE TV

The Houston Chronicle published an interview with Jimmy Buffett this week where he discussed the Margaritaville TV Internet television station he's created. It's the only TV station owned, operated, bankrolled, and starring a rock 'n' roller. The station is packed with videos and memories. As Buffett puts it, he's been "living my life like a song," making music for nearly a half century.

The main event of Margaritaville TV will be live telecasts of Buffett concerts in high definition and full stereo. The station was launched almost 2 weeks ago at Jimmy's concert at The Woodlands. The concert was attended by over 16,500 Parrotheads, and watched by thousands more in places like China, Australia, France, South America and Africa. Jimmy explained, "I like technology. I think there's a lot of people out there who would like to see our show but can't. They might be in secondary markets, or they don't want to put up with the hassle of coming to a show."

Buffett has been doing fewer tours, with fewer shows in fewer cities in recent years. Which means fewer people get to see the concert in person. Jimmy continued, "I didn't know it was going to last this long, at this pace. If you do the math, we're only doing about 20 shows this year. I still like doing it, but I'm also 67 years old. I've had a good run. I've got a lot of things that I want to do that don't involve me being on the road. With Margaritaville TV, fans can watch the show now."

Buffett isn't worried that people may stay home and watch Margaritaville TV instead of buying tickets and coming to his concerts. "Tonight's show is on TV. But you still see people scalping tickets in the parking lot. It's the law of supply and demand. There's still a lot of demand for our shows." If you haven't already, be sure to check out Margaritaville TV online at Margaritaville.TV. In addition to live concerts, you'll have access to music videos, behind the scenes, travel videos, recipes, and so much more!


