

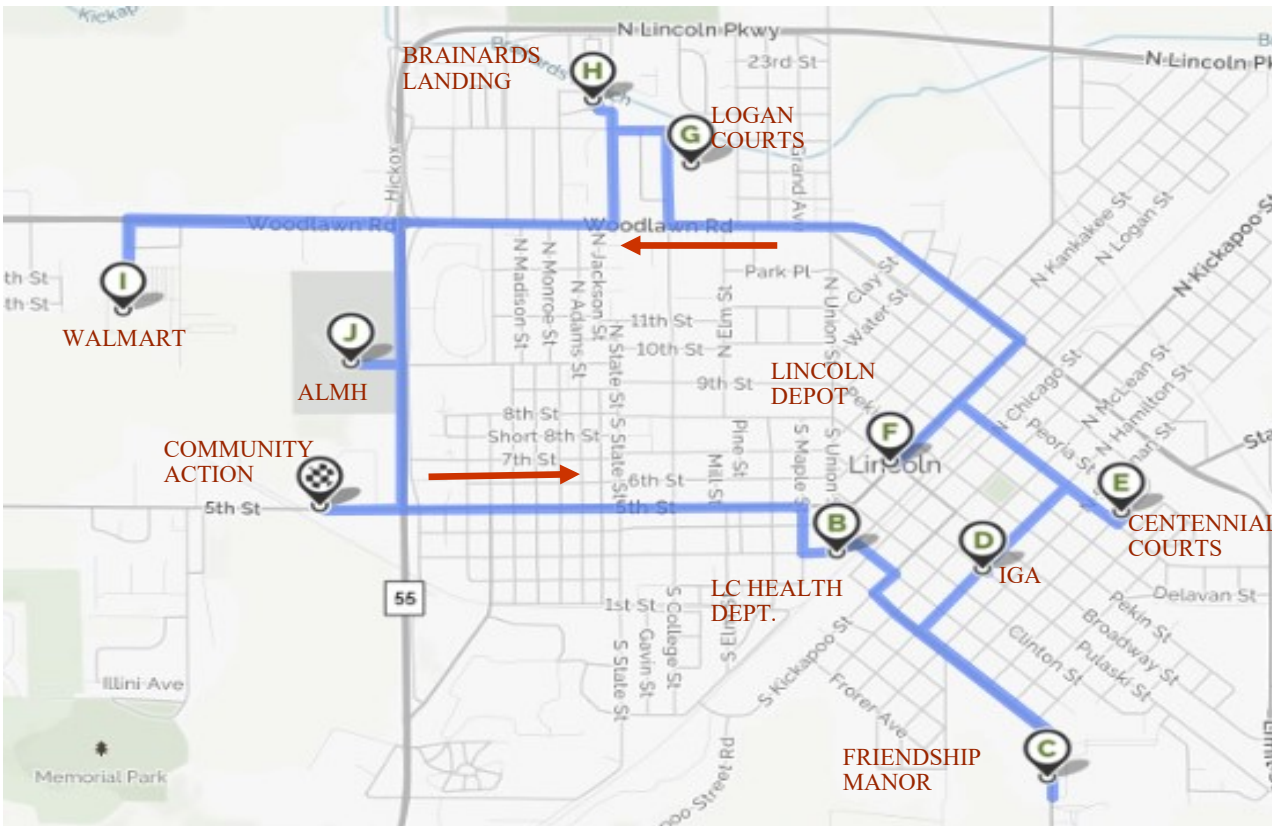


Flex Route Fares PER RIDE IN EACH DIRECTION
