Hello! I would like to welcome all of our new and returning families of Glenbrook Preschool this 2023/24 year

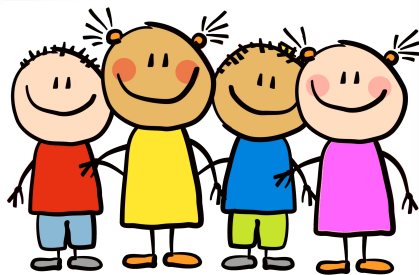

Illness Reminder

If your child is ill, you must keep him/her home (both for your child's sake and to ensure that the other children do not become ill). Your child must be medication-free (including cold medication, Tylenol, Advil, etc.) for 24 hours prior to the start of class time.

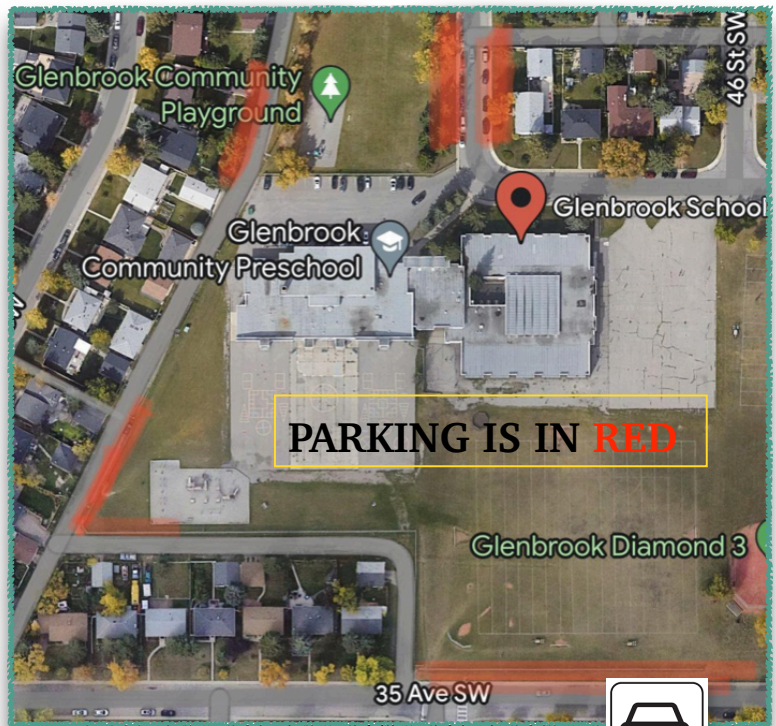
- * If you need to contact us, the preschool phone number is **403-686-6868**. Please leave a message, and our teachers will pick up messages at the end of each class. Please do not call Glenbrook Elementary School, as they are not equipped to answer questions regarding the preschool.
- * Please label everything your child brings to school, and ensure your child brings a backpack containing an extra set of clothes to each class.
- * Please choose VELCRO indoor shoes for your child that have a proper sole on them (instead of slippers), since we must go outdoors during school fire drills. **NO LACES!**
- * Due to issues we have had in the past, we are reminding all parents to please review the preschool's late pick-up policy, found in the Parent Handbook. The Parent Handbook can also answer many of the questions you may have about our preschool.
- * Please remember that our teachers cannot supervise children outside of class time. Why not find a "buddy" parent in your child's class to look after your child in the event you are delayed at pick-up time?
- * Glenbrook Preschool Society will be providing a healthy snack for your child during their preschool class, so there is no need to pack one. In addition, please do not send any other food, such as birthday or holiday treats, to school with your child due to allergy concerns. Even food that has come in contact with peanuts can be potentially dangerous for some children.

Fundraising

Did you know that Glenbrook Preschool Society is not part of the Calgary Board of Education? As an independent, non-profit organization, we pay rent for our preschool classrooms, purchase our own supplies, and pay for caretaking services. Our program has low student:teacher ratios and no mandatory classroom volunteer commitments! We try to keep our tuition fees low and accessible to all families, so each year we typically run 2 fundraisers, one prior to Christmas, and a second in the spring.

All of our fundraising drives are voluntary.



Parking

Glenbrook Elementary School has been very welcoming of our preschool. You can help ensure we maintain this positive relationship by respecting the school's rules regarding parking and child drop off and pick up, as outlined in the Parent Handbook. Please remember – enter only through the south side entrance, and do not park in the staff parking lot. Parking is available on the street at the back of the school and in the alley, noting the no parking signage and being careful not to block neighbourhood garages. Thank you for your cooperation.
