AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HORNICK, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO THE COMPENSATION OF THE COUNCIL AND MAYOR

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Hornick, Iowa:

- **SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED.** Ordinance No. 2019-01 Section 1 which repealed and modifies Chapter 4, Section 2-4-1 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hornick, Iowa, 2013, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:
 - **2-4-1 COMPENSATION.** Effective January 1, 2026, the salary of each Council member is \$70.00 per month, plus \$20.00 for each meeting of the Council attended and for each meeting attended outside of Council meetings. Mileage reimbursement at the current city approved rate shall be paid for meetings attended out of city limits. Council compensation to be made quarterly.
- **SECTION 2. SECTION MODIFIED.** Ordinance No. 2019-01 Section 2 which repeals and modifies Chapters 4, Section 2-4-2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hornick, Iowa, 2013, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:
 - **2-4-2 COMPENSATION.** Effective January 1, 2026, the salary of Mayor is \$150.00 per month, plus \$40.00 for each meeting of the Council attended and for each meeting attended outside of Council meetings. Mileage reimbursement at the current city approved rate shall be paid for meetings attended out of city limits. Mayor compensation to be made quarterly.
- **SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
- **SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by the law.
