Jim Sprunger, 53, of Owendale died Thursday, March 9, 2000, at Huron Memorial Hospital in Bad Axe after complications from surgery. He was born March 20, 1946, in Bad Axe to Oliver and Melba (Miller) Sprunger. His father preceded him in death on Nov. 17, 1996.
