### Registration/ Timeline:

- Tournament waters will go OFF-LIMITS on Wednesday the 29<sup>th</sup> of October 2025 at midnight until 0500 Sunday November 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Reminder, Daylight Savings Time goes into effect on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of November 2025. Clocks will roll back one (1) hour.

### Sunday 2 November 2025:

**Stillhouse Hollow Reservoir is currently 0.34 above normal pool. Water Temperature is 81 degrees and stained. Caution must always be used while on the lake.**

### Tournament Day

- Check-in, Boat number draw and Livewell checks will begin at 5:00am, at the ramp at Stillhouse Hollow Marina.
- For safety reasons and to comply with the Youth Sports Safety Act, all boats must have 3 persons, 2 student anglers and a Boat Captain. If for whatever reason an angler cannot make it, that team must provide an observer.
- This will **NOT** be a trailering event. This is a numbered launch tournament.
- The Official Launch site will be Stillhouse Hollow Marina boat ramps.
- The Official Launch Time is Safe Light.
- You may enter tournament waters beginning at 5:00am.
  - a) All Boat Captains need to be mine full of the "No-Wake Zones" and be sure you are not cutting off other anglers as you leave the ramp area.
  - b) All Boat Captains must observe any, and all posted "No Fishing Areas" / "No Boat Areas"
- The Official weigh-in site will be the Stillhouse Hollow Marina Pavilion area.
- The Scales will open at 2:00pm. Anglers must be in line by 2:30pm with their catch Any angler coming in after the 2:30pm cut-off will incur a late penalty. If a team reports 15 minutes or more late, that team will be disqualified from the event and their weight will not count.
- Anglers and Boat Captains that do not come to the weigh-in site must text 254-368-0294 once they are off the water to ensure everyone is off the water.

## Awards

- Scholarships, Awards, and Prizes will be awarded after weigh-in (approximately 3:00pm).
- Awards will be given to the 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place Teams, plus a Big Bass award. Additional awards will be given 1 place for every 10 entries.
- Awards for the heaviest sack will be given to the Top True Junior Angler Team.
  - a) **TRUE** Junior Angler Teams are those teams in which both anglers are junior anglers (6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade).
