**VOLUNTEERS CHECK-IN**

<b>Entry</b>	Fee waived <i>for day-use only</i> per the Park Rangers, tell them you are a volunteer
<b>Check-in</b>	Check in at the Ramada near the beach area, coffee & breakfast muffins will be provided
<b>Set-up</b>	Event Set-Up

**6:30 a.m. – 7:00 a.m.**

**BOATERS LAUNCH**

<b>Launch</b>	Launch your boat– non boaters will be available to assist
<b>Stand-by for loading kids</b>	Once you have launched, proceed to the beach area and tie-up your boat close by or stay with your boat close by the ramp near the beach area, which is where we will load kids.

**6:30 a.m.**

**KIDS CHECK-IN**

<b>Arrival</b>	Kids will check-in at the ramada near the beach
<b>Breakfast</b>	Breakfast muffins will be available to snack on upon check-in for kids and volunteers
<b>Life Vest Pick-Up</b>	Each child and their mentor will get fitted with a life jacket
<b>T-Shirts</b>	Each child, mentor and volunteer may pick-up an event t-shirt to keep
<b>Rods &amp; Reels</b>	Each child will be given a rod/reel to use for the day and keep
<b>Bait / Tackle</b>	Each child will be given a tackle pack to use and keep
<b>Snack Packs &amp; Water</b>	Each child will be given snack packs and water to take on the boat

**LOAD KIDS ON BOATS**

<b>Load @ Marina</b>	Kids and their mentors will be loaded onto boats depending on room available
<b>Blast-off</b>	Take off and show your kid(s) what a great day of fishing is all about!
<i>SAFETY FIRST: AZ law requires kids 12 and under to keep their life jackets on at all times while underway on any watercraft! Older children or adult guests may remove life jacket if desired only when the big motor is off.</i>

**RETURN TO DOCK**

<b>Unload</b>	Boats will return to the dock where the kids were loaded and take turns pulling up to the docks to let their passengers unload
<b>Kids -</b>	Kids and their mentors should walk back to the ramada by the beach area
<b>Boaters -</b>	Boaters should allow all the passengers to unload before leaving the water – non boaters who helped you launch will return to pick you up. Once you have loaded your boat and parked, please head back to the ramada by the beach area
