

Dear Parents,

Auditions for the Missoula Children's Theatre production of "TREASURE ISLAND" will be held Monday, February 13, 2017, from 3:30 to 5:30 p.m., at the Niles Theater, 127 S. Main in Alturas. There are roles available for young people of all ages, kindergarten through twelfth grade. Approximately fifty to sixty local children will be cast to appear in the show with the MCT Actor/Directors.



NOTE: Not everyone who auditions is guaranteed a part in the show. Children wishing to audition should arrive at the scheduled time and plan to stay for the entire two-hour session. It is a group audition – **no advance preparation is necessary.**

Rehearsals will be conducted every day from 3:30 to 5:30 p.m., and 6:00 to 8:00 p.m., at the Niles Theater. Though not all cast members will be needed at every session, those auditioning must have a clear schedule for the entire week, able to attend any rehearsals necessary for their role if selected. A detailed rehearsal schedule is distributed at the conclusion of the auditions. Cast members scheduled for the full four hours in one day will be asked to bring a sack supper or snack. The first rehearsal begins approximately 30 minutes after the audition.

Performances will be on Saturday, February 18, 2017 at 1:00 p.m., for the Matinee, and 5:00 p.m. for the evening performance, and will be presented at the Niles Theater in Alturas.

The children in the cast will be called for a rehearsal before the performance that day. All those cast must be available for all scheduled performances.

This coming year, nearly 65,000 cast members across the globe, will take to the stage to the delight and applause of their families, friends, community, neighbors and teachers.
