



Our Mission

The mission of Leadership Portage County is to provide unique insights into Portage County; to explore and develop various styles, theories and examples of leadership; to provide opportunities to build relationships and networks; and to serve as a catalyst for volunteerism and positive change in Portage County.

About the Program

Leadership Portage County is a nine-month experience designed to develop active and influential leaders with the appropriate knowledge to address important issues facing Portage County. Participants are engaged in an exploration of the region to gain a deep understanding of the county's opportunities and challenges. These experiential learning opportunities also provide professional development to assist participants in building their personal leadership skills.

The program begins in September with a class dinner followed by a two-day retreat. It continues through May with eight one-day sessions, ending with graduation in May. The sessions are conducted by leaders in their field who cover topics related to the day's theme.

Attendance Requirements

1. Attendance at the opening retreat is mandatory, beginning Wednesday 6-8PM Thursday and Friday 8AM-5PM.
2. In addition to the opening retreat, class members are expected to attend eight one-day programs for the entire day. Program days generally being at 8 AM and end around 5 PM.
3. To qualify for graduation, participants may not miss more than two class days.
4. Leadership Portage County must be notified before an absence.

COMMITMENT PLEDGE

Leadership Portage County aims for full participation of each class member. The experience begins in January with a mandatory retreat. Following the opening retreat, the Leadership Portage County program continues on a monthly basis for eight months. Participants are expected to attend one full-day session (generally 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM) per month beginning in February and concluding in August. The closing retreat/graduation in August is also mandatory.

Individuals selected to participate, pledge to fully dedicate their time and focus to Leadership Portage County during class sessions. To fulfill graduation requirements, each participant may not miss more than two class sessions. Leadership Portage County must be notified before an absence. Attendance for less than a full program day may be counted as an absence. Individuals missing more than two sessions may be asked to withdraw. Tuition is not refundable in the event a student is asked to withdraw.

TUITION AGREEMENT

Tuition for the 2022 Leadership Portage County class is \$2,000.00. It may be paid by the applicant, the applicant's employer, or a sponsor. Tuition is non-refundable and is due no later than September 1, 2021
